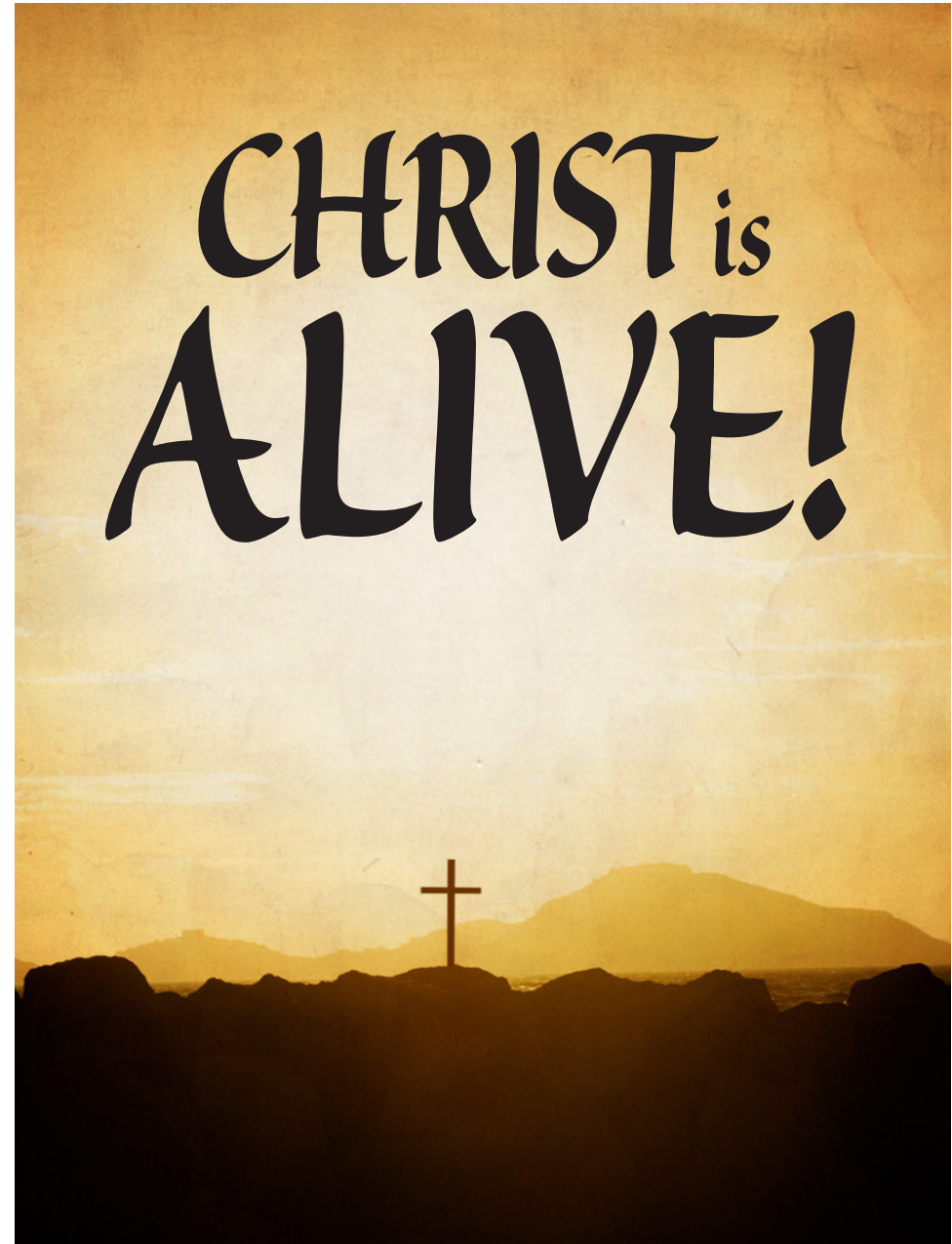

library corner

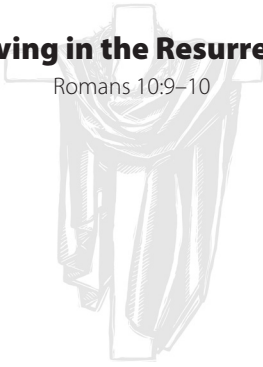

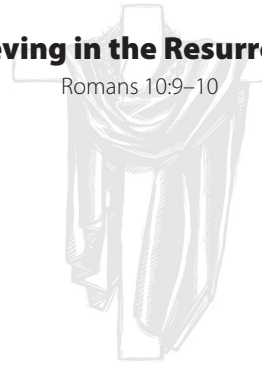
